Preparation of Database for monitoring the price of Medical Devices

A meeting is scheduled to be held on 15th March,2017 at NPPA for discussion with Medical Devices Industry Associations on **Preparation of Database for monitoring the price of Medical Devices.**

In a meeting held on 18.02.2017 chaired by Secretary (Pharmaceuticals), DoP, it was decided that IPDMS for medical device sector shall be modified in consultations with medical device manufactures /importers/marketers/associations to suit the needs of medical device sectors and shall be finalised by 31.03.2017 and It would be mandatory for all medical device manufactures/importers/marketers to upload the requisite information on IPDMS and the last date for 100% compliance will be 30.06.2017.

The following notified medical devices are considered as drug under Drugs and cosmetics Act.

- 1. Disposable Hypodermic Syringes
- 2. Disposable Hypodermic Needles
- 3. Disposable perfusion Sets
- 4. In vitro Diagnostic Devices Of HIV, HBsAg and HCV
- 5. Cardiac Stents
- 6. Drug Eluting Stents
- 7. Catheters
- 8. Intra Ocular Lenses
- 9. I.V Cannulae
- 10. Bone Cements
- 11. Heart Valves
- 12. Scalp Vein Set
- 13. Orthopaedic Implants
- 14. Internal Prosthetic Replacements

The following products are also regulated as 'Drugs' under Drugs and cosmetics Act.

- 1. Blood Grouping Sera
- 2. Ligatures, Sutures and Staplers
- 3. Intra Uterine Devices(Cu-T)
- 4. Condoms
- 5. Tubal Rings
- 6. Surgical Dressings
- 7. Umbilical Tapes
- 8. Blood /Blood component Bags
